



COURSE

Yamaru Forest Trail (1,000 m; approx. 30 min.)

This trail takes you through a dense forest of huge banyan trees, community of 60,000 sago palms, and many other subtropical trees and plants. As you walk along this trail, breathe in the refreshing energy emanated from the thick dense growth of plants and trees.



A portion of the trail (600 m) is wheelchair accessible.

Panoramic Trail of Fantastic Rocks and Beautiful Sea (1,200 m; approx. 60 min.)

Experience the world's northernmost tropical karst landscape formed when a layer of limestone rose up 250 million years ago. Enjoy magnificent scenery of sheer rocks rising up close together and a panoramic view from the top of the mountains looking over the vast sea stretching out to the horizon.

Daisekirinzan Guided Tours

Our expert guides will take you on a guided tour of Daisekirinzan, a designated national park. Learn more about the wilderness of Yamaru by observing and seeing for yourself the history of this tropical karst landscape as well as the animals and plants that live and grow here.

Guided Spiritual Tour

The four rocky mountains of Ashimui are Shinokuse, Afuri, Shijara and Iheya. On the guided spiritual tour, you will also be escorted to areas outside the regular trails to visit legendary spots and places of worship in Daisekirinzan, a land recounted in Ryukyuan creation mythology. You will experience the profoundness of Okinawa's nature worship where people have prayed since ancient times.

MUSEUM

Museum (Admission free)



The museum houses a collection of rocks representative of 41 municipalities in Okinawa Prefecture. From the way in which rocks are distributed, visitors learn how the Okinawan islands originated and formed. There are also displays of various stone folk implements, which show us how our ancestors lived and their wisdom.



【 Restaurant 】

This restaurant offers a selection of Okinawan cuisine that includes Agu pork, Yamaru herbs and other choice ingredients. There is also a menu for those with allergy or diet restrictions. There is also a Japanese-style dining area and play area for the convenience of guests with small children. You won't want to miss the fantastic view of the ocean as it stretches out towards the horizon.

Recommended Stops in Yamaru



Cape Hedo
(About a 3-min. drive from Daisekirinzan)

Northernmost tip of the Okinawa main island. Enjoy the spectacular view of raised coral reefs and the vast ocean extending farther than the eye can see. From here, you can even see Yoron Island in Kagoshima Prefecture.



Michi-no-eki Yuiyui Kunigami (Roadside Station)
(About a 25-min. drive from Daisekirinzan)

This is the main hub when driving around Yamaru. The rest area has shops offering Kunigami Village specialties, restaurants, eateries, open-air market, tourist information and other services.



Kouri Ocean Tower
(About a 45-min. drive from Daisekirinzan)

The view from the tower is picture perfect. As you look out from the tower top, you can relish the view of Kouri Bridge, the emerald green sea and other scenes that will take your breath away.
