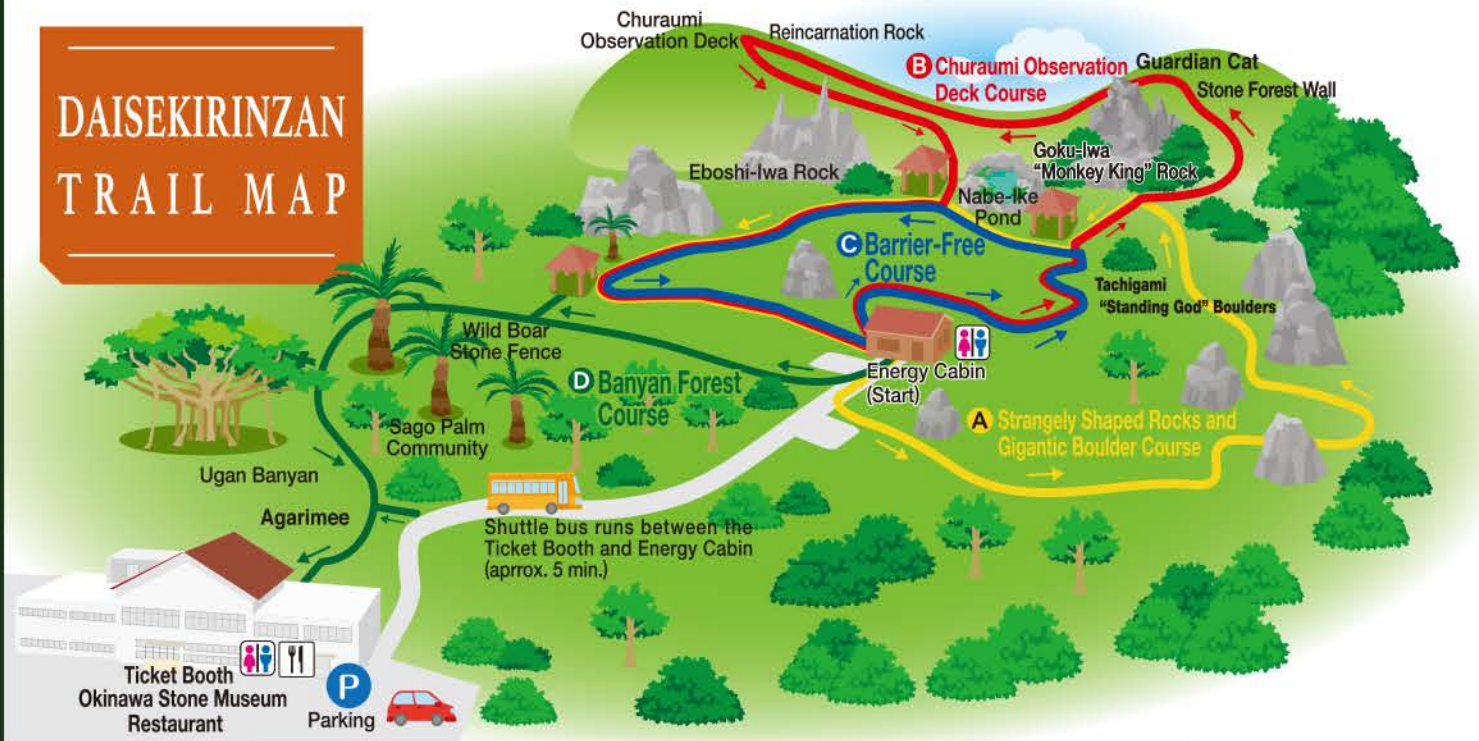


# DAISEKIRINZAN TRAIL MAP



## COURSE

**A Strangely Shaped Rocks and Gigantic Boulder Course**  
(1,000 m / about 35 minutes)

A course to experience the world's northernmost tropical karst topography created by the rise of a limestone layer approximately 250 million years ago. The landscape created by these huge rocks standing proudly with trees full of life is like that of a different world

**B Churaumi Observation Deck Course**  
(900 m / about 30 minutes)

A course with many highlights where you can enjoy the superb view of steep rocks standing tall as well as the panoramic views overlooking the sea from above the observation deck. The course is also host to many places of worship and legendary rocks.

**C Barrier-Free Course**  
(600 m / about 20 minutes)

A wooden deck course that is safe for the elderly and wheelchair users. A sheltered rest area is also available.

**D Banyan Forest Course**  
(900 m / about 30 minutes)

This trail takes you through a dense forest of huge banyan trees, community of 60,000 sago palms, and many other subtropical trees and plants. As you walk along this trail, breathe in the refreshing energy emanated from the thick dense growth of plants and trees.

## MUSEUM

**Okinawa Stone Museum** (Admission free)



The museum houses a collection of rocks representative of 41 municipalities in Okinawa Prefecture. From the way in which rocks are distributed, visitors learn how the Okinawan islands originated and formed. There are also displays of various stone folk implements, which show us how our ancestors lived and their wisdom.



## 【Restaurant】

This restaurant offers a selection of Okinawan cuisine that includes Okinawan pork, Yambaru herbs and other choice ingredients. There is also a menu for those with allergy or diet restrictions. There is also a Japanese-style dining area and play area for the convenience of guests with small children. You won't want to miss the fantastic view of the ocean as it stretches out towards the horizon.



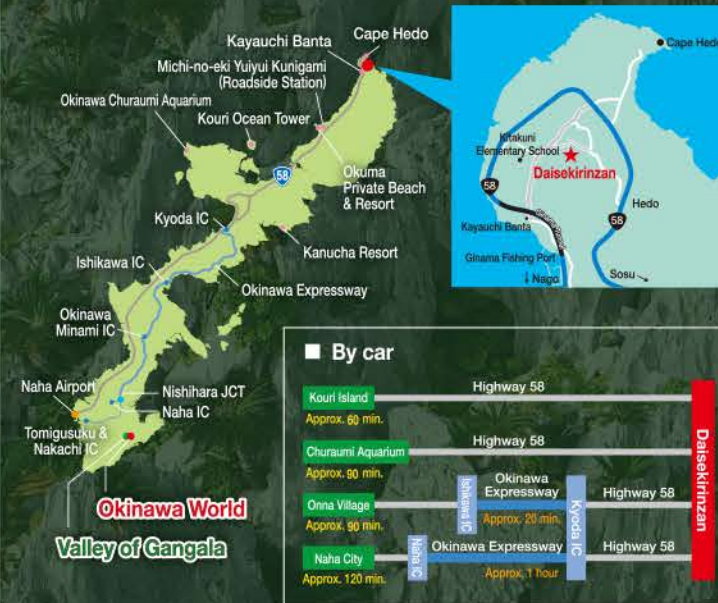

## ■ Access



**Drive safely & watch out for wild animals**  
The endangered Okinawa rail is known to be on or near roads, so please be on the lookout for this bird and other animals as you drive carefully.

## ■ Recommended Stops in Yambaru



**Cape Hedo**

(About a 3-min. drive from Daisekirinzan)  
Northernmost tip of the Okinawa main island. Enjoy the spectacular view of raised coral reefs and the vast ocean extending farther than the eye can see. From here, you can even see Yoron Island in Kagoshima Prefecture.

**Michi-no-eki Yuiyui Kunigami (Roadside Station)**

(About a 25-min. drive from Daisekirinzan)  
This is the main hub when driving around Yambaru. The rest area has shops offering Kunigami Village specialties, restaurants, eateries, open-air market, tourist information and other services.

**Kouri Ocean Tower**

(About a 60-min. drive from Daisekirinzan)  
The view from the tower is picture perfect. As you look out from the tower top, you can relish the view of Kouri Bridge, the emerald green sea and other scenes that will take your breath away.
